Firstly here are a few things from the Bowls Committee meeting this week.

#### Social Bowls.

It was decided to trial Saturday Club Select in a triples format. This is a trial for the rest of July to see if we can attract more players on a Saturday.

Also on all winter social bowls days the bell will ring at 1.30 or 2hrs after the start of play. #### Barefoot Bowls,

It is the biggest income earner for the club and will commence this year on Friday 4th of November. David Youl has kindly taken on the job again albeit at arms length.
