ETIQUETTE

Bowls is a friendly game. Let the exercise of consideration for others, courtesy and good sportsmanship add charm to a skilful and rewarding sport.

Here are a few tips which may help:

- 1 A major part of our game is etiquette respect your opponents and your own players
- 2 Bowls should not be dropped on the green.
- 3 Do not stand on the edges of the green.
- 4 Smoking is NOT permitted on club premises
- 5 Check before you remove a bowl from the rink.
- 6 Bowls should not be kicked in until the shot/s have been decided.
- 7 After the last bowl by your opponent pick up the mat & place on bank.
- 8 After delivering a bowl, a player should retire at least two metres behind the mat, or the head.
- 9 Don't delay the games.
- 10 Don't wander about or move in the head when a player is about to deliver a bowl and, particularly, do not stand in line with the boundary pegs.
- 11 Don't talk in a loud tone whilst a player is about to deliver a bowl.
- 12 When watching a match, always observe strict neutrality. Advice or criticism must not be given.
- 13 All bowlers should know, and understand the rules of the game.
- 14 Retire to the bank when not 'in play'.
- 15 Never leave the rink/green without informing your playing partner & opponents

ETIQUETTE

DO

1 Be a good sport.

- 2 Give full support to the members of your team.
- 3 Advise your opponent if unable to keep an appointment for any game.
- 4 Always conform to the correct attire for the game.
- 5. Applaud good shots and generally encourage all players.
- 6 Keep still and silent whilst your opponent and other members of the team are playing.
- 7 Always watch the play. Take an interest without interfering.
- 8 Play always for the side and not individual success.
- 9 Return mats and jacks and rakes to shed at the finish of play (LEADERS).
- 10 Close sun shelters and return umbrellas to shed

DO NOT

- 1 Be a bad sport.
- 2 Argue with the Skip on the shot to play.
- 3 Develop mannerisms which indicate displeasure at indifferent play or success.
- 4 Follow the bowl further than the rules allow, or stray on the adjoining rink.
- 5 Have excuses for bad play.
- 6 Dispute the Umpire's decision.
- 7 Give advice to players from the bank.
- 8 Abuse the privileges of the Club.
- 9 Interfere with the determination of or decision of those bowlers responsible for checking bowls' score in the head.

CLUB POLICIES

Smoking:

Smoking is not allowed anywhere within the perimeter boundary of the Mornington Bowling Club.

Drinking and eating on the greens and surrounds.

Players are encouraged to drink water whilst play is in progress. There is to be no drinking of any beverages or eating of food on the greens.

Mobile phone and sound devices.

Use of mobile phone and similar communication and sound devices is not permitted on the green while play is in progress unless previous permission is given for medical reasons or family concerns etc. by the event co-ordinator.

Excessive heat rule for Club events.

When the approved thermometer temperature reads 35°C or more, play shall cease until the temperature falls below 35° Celsius.

Social Bowls (see Social Bowls Guidelines)

Club championships:

Club uniform is to be worn by Players and Markers in all knockout rounds and finals

Entry for any club championship signifies agreement with the conditions of play and the playing schedule. Games are to be completed by the end of the play-by date. Players should not enter championships or competitions if they cannot include the played-by day for each round in their weekly bowls schedule. Players must not practice on a rink that they will or may use in a club championship on the same day. The penalty is disqualification from the championship.

Bowlers arms.

Members can use a 'Bowlers Arm' in Social, Club & Bowls events. The 'Bowlers Arm' must be an approved Bowls Australia device. A 'Bowlers Arm' is to assist an injured or disabled player to participate in the game of bowls. Whenever a player commences using an approved bowlers arm in a game, the player must use it for the remainder of that game. This does not apply to the rolling of the jack, which can be rolled either by hand or by a bowlers arm.

Dumping/ Dropping bowls on the green.

Dumping and dropping bowls onto the green from greater than 15cm can cause damage to the surface and subsurface of synthetic and grass greens. If you're dumping the bowl, contact one of the coaches to help you overcome this problem. Bowls should be placed on the green. Do not drop your bowl from the bank onto the green. <u>Practice.</u>

No practice or play is permitted on a green or rink that is closed for the day or prior to Green opening time. Greens are open from 9:00am during daylight saving and from 10:00am through winter. Always check the Greens Direction Board to see which way you are to practice or play on any of our greens.

USE OF GREENS

To try to avoid the conflict that occurs from time to time regarding the use of the Greens, the Bowls Committee advises that the following rules shall apply.

- Always check the 'Greens Direction' Board to see direction of play, and which Greens/Rinks are available.
- All competitions shall be under the control of the Bowls Co-ordinator & Match Committee.
- Bowling attire as directed by the Bowls Committee to be worn by players and markers in all club events.
- Competitions may be played only on those rinks allocated by the Bowls Co-ordinator in conjunction with the Greens Liaison Officer.
- Competitions may be played on the same green as a tournament or match providing, where practicable, there is a separation of at least one rink.
- Members not in the authorised attire may practice if a separate green is available or after the tournament or pennant play is finished.
- As a courtesy to the Greens Liaison Officer & Greens Keeper, please give at least 24 hours notice of play and add a note on the whiteboard adjacent to the greenkeeper's machinery shed.

SOCIAL BOWLS GUIDELINES

The Bowls Committee has established the following guidelines to assist members. It is your personal responsibility in making sure you get a game by following these guidelines. The Bowls Committee believes that every MBC member who has followed these guidelines should be guaranteed a game.

- 1 Entries open 1 week prior to the advertised starting time.
- 2 Entries close 6:00pm the evening prior to game day. Following these guidelines should guarantee you a game.
- 3 Members' entries received after the closure time will be placed on a standby list and the organisers will telephone you if they are able to adjust numbers to fit you in. We will try to include you for a game but cannot give a guarantee.
- 4 If you have registered to play and wish to cancel, please notify the organiser at least 2½ hours prior to game start. This may help to provide late entries with a Game.
- 5 It is your own responsibility to place your name on the play lists.
- **6** On Nominated days teams of two or three can be nominated.
- 7 Single entries are not to add their names to a team without the agreement of the team they wish to join.
- 8 The organisers will determine the placement of other single entries.

A neat standard of dress is expected of all players. This includes a collared shirt in summer and correct bowls shoes. During winter, the mufti dress code may be varied for warmth. Mufti is the usual attire for social bowls. (Not Logoed/ striped tracksuit pants.). On special occasions, players may be required to wear Club uniform or Bowls approved attire. This requirement will be noted on the signup sheet. Whites or Club uniform is to be worn when Pennant is played at home.

NOTE: Roll ups for social bowls close one hour prior to the start of the game. Please ask the organisers which rinks can be used for a roll up.
