CONDITIONS OF PLAY

ALL Matches will be played in accordance with the
Laws of the Sport of Bowls – Crystal Mark 4th Edition including Domestic
Regulations for Australia April 2023

Eligibility & Entry Conditions (As determined by the MBC Match Committee)

Serious consideration whether you should enter to be made if you are unavailable to play or likely to be away at time during the tournament.

Format of Play

Knockout Play 25 Shots Up Semi & Final 25 Shots Up

Cost \$8.00 per player

Payment of match fee to be made at the bar, your receipt with your name on to be deposited in the slot outside the back office.

No refund of match fee if your match is forfeited for any reason.

No practice on green one on the day of play

Trial Ends

One trial end in each direction is permitted prior to the commencement time.

Draw To be made available on Friday 27th October 2023

The blind draw for the knockout rounds will be conducted by the MBC Bowls Match Committee. Once the draws have been published, no late entries will be accepted, and the draw will not be changed.

Starting Times

Knockout Games will commence on or after 29th October 2023

The final will be played on 10th December commencing 10:00am

Players will organise a **mutually agreed day and time** for knockout play.

Games to be completed by the dates nominated by the Match Committee.

The game date & time is to be notified to the Greens keeper and members through the whiteboard opposite the Mats & Jacks Cupboard.

A Marker is required for singles competition. Losing players may be required to perform marking duties in subsequent rounds. The Final will be marked by a person nominated by the Match Committee.

Footwear and Attire

MBC Club Uniform or Whites with correct footwear to be worn in all rounds by players.

The Controlling Body has the right to alter completion dates and the conditions of play if necessary.
